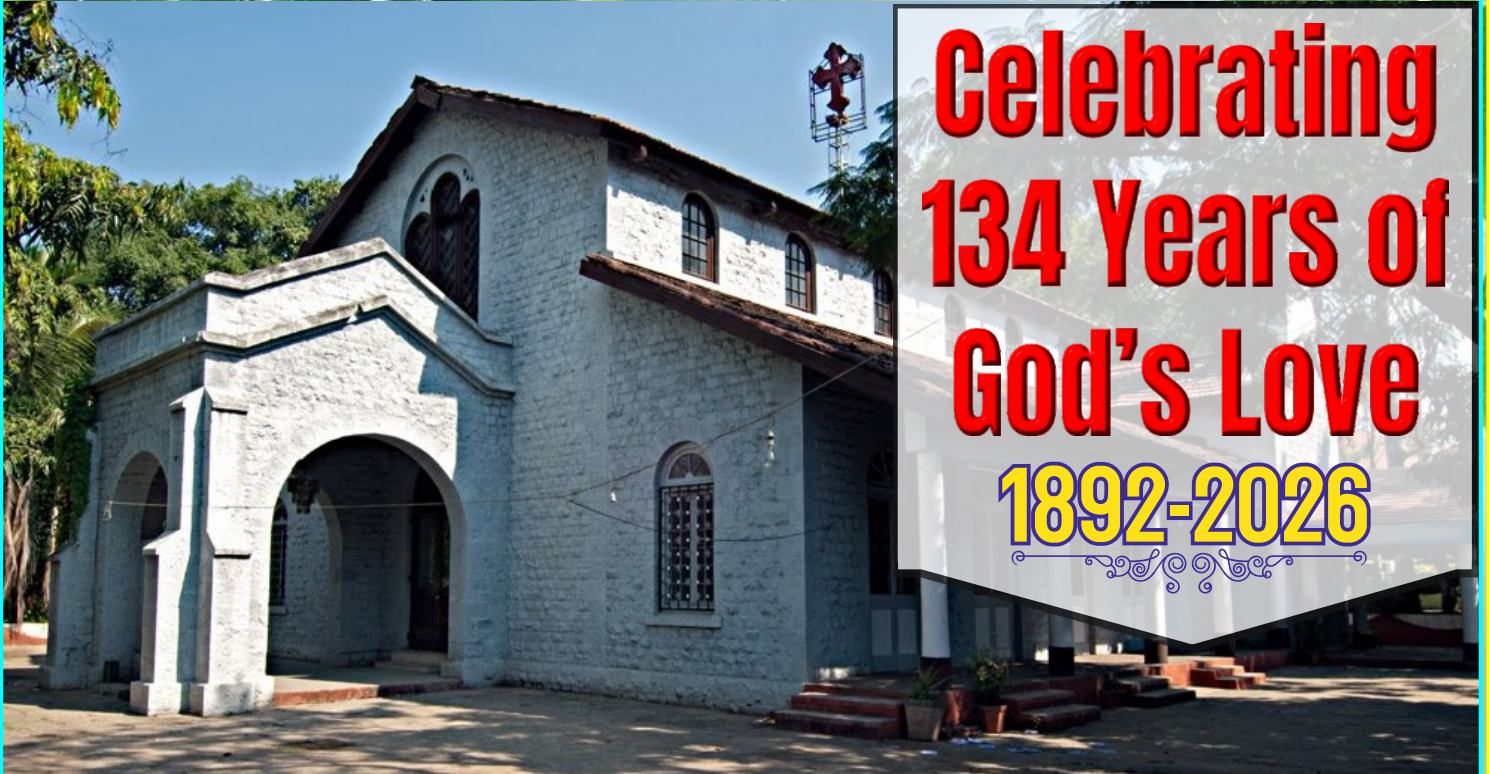

நாமும் பேதுருவை போல, பவுலை போல வாழ தேவன் கிருபை செய்வாராக!

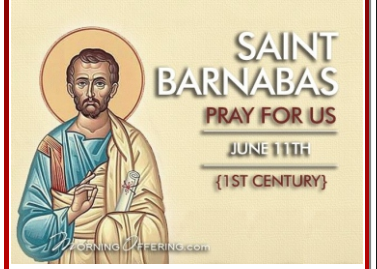

Jude 1:21:- Keep Yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

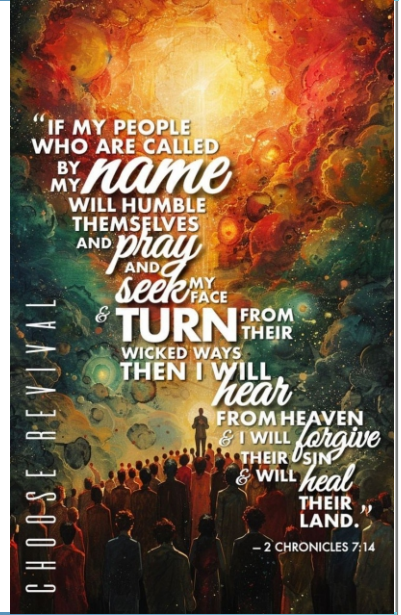
This verse fits perfectly with gifts, witness, and family growth; it is a call to Spirit-empowered faith-building, bold love, and prayer in Jude's concise letter.

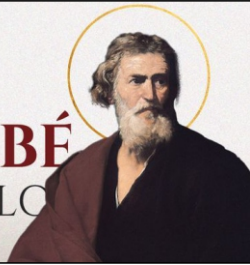

They were killed on orders of Mwanga II, the King of Buganda. The deaths took place at a time when there was a three-way religious struggle for political influence at the Buganda royal court.
5 th	 <p>World Environment DAY</p>	World Environment Day It is celebrated annually on 5 th June and encourages awareness and action for the protection of the environment. It was established in 1972 by the UN at the Stockholm Conference on the Human Environment. One year later, in 1973, the first WED was held with the theme "Only one earth". It has been a platform for raising awareness on environmental issues such as marine pollution, overpopulation, global warming, sustainable development and wildlife crime.
7 th	 <p>NATIONAL CANCER SURVIVORS DAY</p>	Cancer Survivors Day Cancer Survivors Day is a secular holiday celebrated on the first Sunday in June primarily in the United States of America. 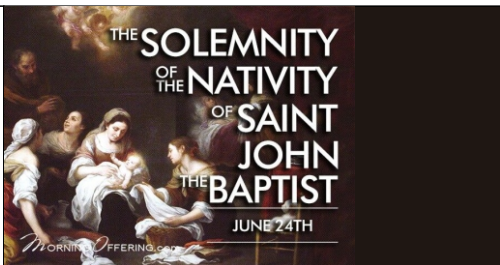

On the fourth Sunday of the month, we observe Mission Sunday led by one of our fellowship groups and we pray especially for missionaries serving the Lord.

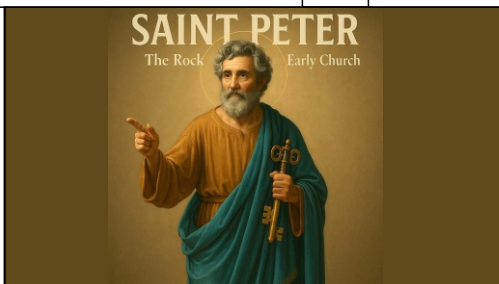

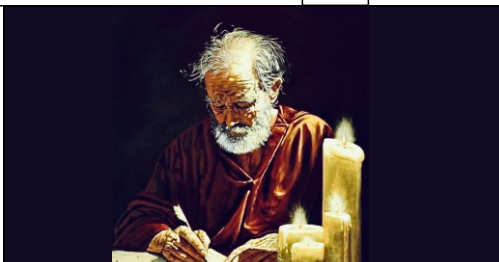

The Day of Paul is commonly observed on June 29th. It honours the martyrdom of Paul, a foundational apostle, in Rome, commemorating his death during the early Christian persecutions under Emperor Nero. Paul was beheaded rather than crucified because he was a Roman citizen.

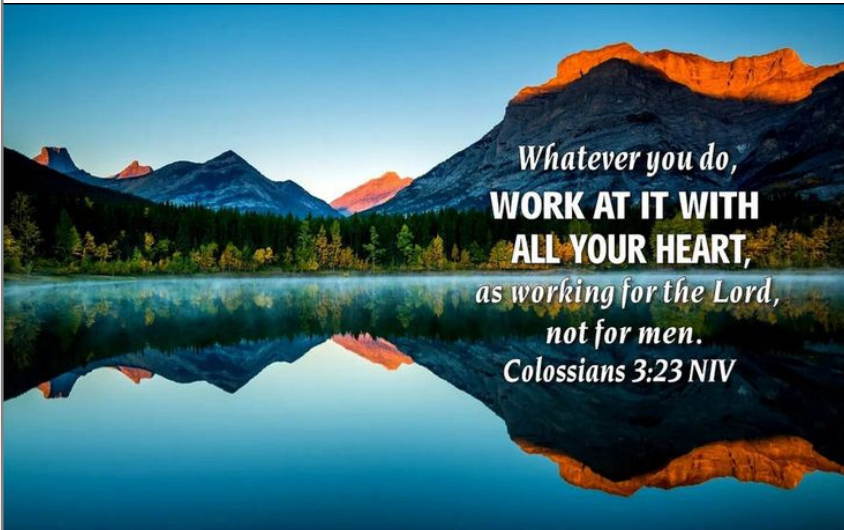

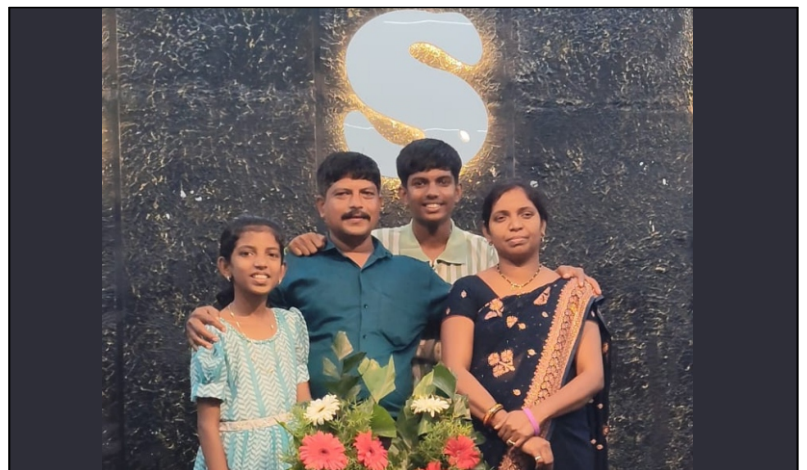
